Transfer Prep Guide	This guide includes recommendations on what you can do now to help you successfully transfer to a 4-year institution.
Transfer Research Worksheet	Planning a successful transfer includes exploration of potential transfer destinations, their programs, and admissions requirements. Keep track of your research by using this document.
Assured Admissions Information	Many universities have assured (or guaranteed) admissions. This list includes transfer admissions requirements for universities in Texas.
Transfer Programs for Students with an AAS	Students with an AAS can transfer to specialized bachelor's degree programs such as BAAS, BAS, and BAT degrees. This list includes some available programs to explore, including ACC's bachelor degree options.
Texas Guarantee Tuition Programs	Trellis Strategies has compiled a list of Texas colleges that offer free tuition based on family/household income. Note that not all schools on this list offer their programs to transfer students, and program requirements vary by institution. Read each description carefully, and visit the college's website to learn more.
Texas Common Course Numbering System (TCCNS)	The TCCNS website helps students and their advisors determine both course equivalency and degree applicability of transfer credit between Texas institutions.
Aid Offer Comparison Worksheet	The NASFAA Financial Aid Offer Comparison Worksheet is a printable tool created by the National Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators. It helps students and families evaluate
